The Baltimore County Department of Recreation and Parks provides safe and attractive public park space throughout Baltimore County. It serves over 800,000 residents within Baltimore County. The Department of Recreation and Parks provide comprehension recreation and parks programs, facilities, and services. They strive to preserve, enhance and protect our open spaces to enrich the quality of life for present and future generations in a safe and secure environment.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The purpose of this project is to develop a new park within Southeast Towson, which tentatively is called Radebaugh park. The property that is for sale is in the heart of the residential community of Aigburth Manor - a neighborhood that does not currently have any public park space within its boundaries. This neighborhood has been identified having a deficit of open space access according to Maryland open space policies and research performed by NeighborSpace, a land trust in Baltimore County. This project will provide passive both passive and active open space, as well as a safe passageway that will connect Aigburth Manor and other adjacent neighborhoods to the local high school, Towson High School. The requested funds will help to complete the purchase of this property, provide planning and design for the new use of the space, demolish greenhouses that are currently on the site, and redevelop the property into a new park.
