It is the mission of The Theatre, a non-profit organization, to preserve, restore and maintain The Maryland Theatre, as a historic property and to provide quality entertainment, educational and cultural offerings to the community at large. Built in 1915, designed by renowned architect Thomas Lamb, The historic Maryland Theatre is the anchor to the Arts & Entertainment district in the city which comprises a high school for the visual and performing arts, offices of the Washington County Arts Council and numerous new businesses and retail enterprises.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Maryland Theatre is requesting support from the State of Maryland in order to begin the planning & design process of rebuilding the front of the Theatre which burned down in the 1974. The front space originally included a long grand lobby and several stories above it filled with retail and residential spaces. The new space will be a collaborative effort involving several arts partners, Washington County Government, The Visitors Bureau, City of Hagerstown, Washington County Public Schools, etc. The new addition will include multipurpose space, educational classrooms, a possible dance studio, possible tourism attractions, art galleries, in addition to theatre administrative office, replacement lobby and additional bathrooms.
