The purpose of this project is to renovate Towson Manor Park, the closest public park to the downtown Towson core. This park has outdated and run-down playground equipment, a gazebo that is falling apart, a terribly leaky water fountain, and space that could be better utilized for additional playground equipment and other recreational activities. It has been determined that a portion of the parking lot that splits the park in half is unused and unnecessary, and will be replaced with additional green space (grey-to-green). Given the current equipment, Towson Manor Park has equipment to serve children up to age 6; so another purpose of this project is to provide equipment and amenities to serve a large range of ages, interests, and abilities.
