10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

Talmudical Academy of Baltimore (TA) is a century old tradition of (Jewish) private education in Maryland. Founded in 1917, the K-12 school has produced thousands of alumni who have taken up the mantle of leadership throughout Maryland, the country, and the world. Over 99% of graduates have attended institutions of higher education, and TA graduates have made a significant impact on their peers, families, and the cities in which they reside. Over the years, the academy has grown well beyond the capacity of its current facilities. Currently situated on a 9.5 acre campus built to accommodate 450 students, the academys current enrollment stands at approximately 1,050 students. The school includes an early childhood center with 205 students, an elementary school with 470 students, a middle school with 232 students, and a high school with 140 students.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Talmudical Academy is expanding its campus with the construction of 2 new buildings, one for early childhood students, and one for high school students. Each building will be built with amenities needed to facilitate excellence in education and extra-curricular activities. When completed, the campus will have capacity to serve up to 1,400 students. To facilitate the high schools athletic and extra-curricular program, a high school gymnasium will be built attached to the new high school building. This gym will be used by students of the school for school athletics, as well as for after-school programs for the academy's students.
