10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

We are in the process of completing a 7,300 sq. ft. based multi-purpose Center. It will service the low income population in East Baltimore including the Latino population . In our community there are large mounts of dropouts, pregnant teens, adults with abilities and desires, but few or no resources to enhance them. There are those desiring to get off and stay off drugs, fighting, disease, and need food and/or clothing.In addition to helping this population our project will cause approximately 15-20 jobs not including volunteer positions. We will be offering several programs including Adult Education, Dance School, Counselimg, Teen Project, Health Initiatives which is free or low cost to members of the Community.

By establishing partnership with many different agencies such as 1st call for Help, Maryland Food Bank, United Way, and East Baltimore Medical Center we serve several hundred pounds of food per week. We are also in partnership with Empowering Minds. We plan to use the funds received from the Board Bill to help build back up the gutted out buildings located at 1005-13 N. Caroline St. Baltimore, Md. 21205. We desire to further our outreach and continue to offer the services to adults and children. There is an urgent need for latch key children to have some place to go after school rather than roam the streets or be at home alone. We will supply that place for many children. We should be able to complete the Project a year after funding is in place.
