10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)							

Community Support Systems, Inc.(CSS) is a private, non-profit social service agency serving southern Prince George's with a continuum of critical safety-net services. These include the CSS Advocacy Program & Assistance Fund, the CSS Shared Senior Living Home, and the CSS Food Pantry Program. Our food pantries, located at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Baden, and Faith United Methodist Church, Accokeek are open a total of 3 mornings a week and provide a selection of nutritious foodstuffs, including fresh vegetables and meats.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The CSS Baden Food Pantry, our flagship service, is located at St. Paul's Episcopal Church Hall. For some time we have needed to improve the entrance and egress to the kitchen. It is dangerous, especially because our volunteers are always carrying food while they negotiate the stairs. Last summer, one of the drivers who picks up donated products actually fell off the stairs, narrowly adverting serious injury. We need an 8 X 8 landing (deck), a loading dock, a new set of stairs, railings, and a 6 X 8 concrete pad. In addition, we would like to fix the pavilion that is used by pantry volunteers and clients. It needs new termite proof posts and a concrete pad.

In addition, there is a pavilion used by food pantry clients to exchange clothing, and, in good weather, used by food pantry volunteers to sort food. This 8 X 16 foot pavilion is in need of new termite-proof posts and needs to be sited on a concrete pad. This is included in the capital improvement costs.

These are state-of-the-art pantries where clients pick what the prefer. They help thousands of people in danger of food insecurity each year. A registered nurse does blood pressure/ blood sugar monitoring, and follow-up services are provided. CSS Advocacy Program & Assistance Fund help is available at our pantries, as well as at our office in Brandywine. Our goal is to help clients get as many resources as are available to improve their circumstance. Our grassroots programs depend on the people-power of 100 volunteers. CSS's mission is to to provide low and moderate income families access to services, to advocate for needed services, and to establish programs and approaches that will elevate the quality of life, dignity, and independence in the community.
