10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)						

Our House is a nationally acclaimed job training program that provides workforce development through our job training program (carpentry/building trades/culinary skills/organic farming/small engine repair/basic computer skills) during the day and academics/life skills in the evenings. Our immediate goal is to get our trainees "off the streets" into a highly structured and intensely supervised home situation that is nurturing and drug/alcohol/violence free. Long term they have the opportunity to earn a Maryland High School Diploma, attain the skills to secure a skilled and meaningful job in the building trades, organic farming, culinary field and become tax-paying members of their communities.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

With completion of the new dormitory Our House will be able to serve 24 at-risk adolescent males ages 16-21. The Departments of Juvenile Services and Social Services are constantly making referrals for placements in this program for older teenage boys who need workforce skills and a high school diploma. To that end we are completing the construction of 24 bed dormitory which will house trainee's rooms, lavatory, lounge/recreation room and laundry facilities. The existing dormitory will be renovated to include classrooms, an enlarged dining hall and an enlarged commercial kitchen for our culinary program. The wood shop will incorporate the old classroom space in the America Legion Trades Building. Our trainees be involved in the renovation process.
