Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have vetoed Senate Bill 33 – *Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Licenses*.

This bill authorizes in Anne Arundel County a holder of a Class BLX license to be issued a music permit, an entertainment permit, an outdoor permit or an outdoor entertainment permit and authorizes a holder of a Class BLX license to be issued a dancing permit, except under specified circumstances. The bill also exempts specified alcoholic beverages licenses in the county from a prohibition against issuing multiple licenses to any one person and exempts a Class BLX license from a prohibition against issuing an alcoholic beverages license for a specified location.

House Bill 642, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 33.
