AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 978, AS AMENDED

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (HB978/934433/1), in line 15 of Amendment No. 1, strike “specifying” and substitute “requiring the Department to collaborate with a county board of education, after a certain period of time, to determine certain other intervention strategies for a certain public school, including certain options that were previously prohibited by law; specifying”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments, in line 4 of Amendment No. 5, strike “**(3)**” and substitute:

“(G) (1) AFTER A 4-YEAR PERIOD FROM THE DATE OF AN INTERVENTION STRATEGY’S IMPLEMENTATION UNDER SUBSECTION (F)(1) OF THIS SECTION, IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT STUDENT OUTCOMES HAVE NOT IMPROVED AT A PUBLIC SCHOOL, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COLLABORATE WITH THE COUNTY BOARD IN DETERMINING ANOTHER INTERVENTION STRATEGY, SUBJECT TO THE EXISTING COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE COUNTY BOARD AND THE EXCLUSIVE BARGAINING REPRESENTATIVE THAT MAY INCLUDE ANY OF THE OPTIONS PREVIOUSLY PROHIBITED UNDER SUBSECTION (F)(2) OF THIS SECTION.
