18 (A) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2018, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT 19 REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR CONDUCTING ENVIRONMENTAL 20 INVESTIGATIONS TO DETERMINE THE SOURCE OF LEAD EXPOSURE FOR CHILDREN 21 WITH ELEVATED BLOOD LEAD LEVELS GREATER THAN OR EQUAL TO 10 22 MICROGRAMS PER DECILITER.

1 (B) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 2 SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL INVESTIGATION GUIDELINES 3 PUBLISHED IN CHAPTER 16 OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN 4 DEVELOPMENT'S GUIDELINES FOR THE EVALUATION AND CONTROL OF 5 LEAD-BASED PAINT HAZARDS IN HOUSING, AS AMENDED.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2017.
