## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Queen Anne's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class D Beer, Wine, and Liquor**  
3 **and Class 9 Limited Distillery Licenses**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing in Queen Anne's County a holder of a Class D beer, wine,  
5 and liquor license and a Class 9 limited distillery license to sell liquor for  
6 off-premises consumption; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages sales in  
7 Queen Anne's County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

21 27–102.

22 This title applies only in Queen Anne's County.

1 (a) There is a Class D beer, wine, and liquor license.

2 (b) The license authorizes the license holder to sell:

3 (1) beer, wine, and liquor for on-premises consumption; [and]

4 (2) beer for off-premises consumption; AND

5 **(3) FOR A HOLDER OF A CLASS 9 LIMITED DISTILLERY LICENSE,**  
6 **LIQUOR FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.**

7 (c) The license may not be issued for use by a drugstore.

8 (d) The annual license fee is \$1,800.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June  
10 1, 2017.
