- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Education
- 17 **7–440.**
- 18 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY.
- 19 (B) THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS SHALL:
- 20 (1) Install and maintain at least two operational video
- 21 CAMERAS ON THE EXTERIOR PREMISES OF EACH BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 22 SITE FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECORDING ILLEGAL ACTIVITY; AND



- 1 (2) PRESERVE THE RECORDINGS MADE BY THE VIDEO CAMERAS FOR 2 AT LEAST 6 MONTHS.
- 3 (c) The board shall adopt regulations to carry out the 4 requirements of this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 $\,$ 1, 2017.
