## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Lean Government Advisory Board; providing for the 4 composition, chair, and staffing of the Board; prohibiting a member of the Board from 5 receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain 6 expenses; requiring the Board to meet at least quarterly and to apply lean principles 7 to analyze the operations and organization of State government, identify certain 8 inefficiencies, and recommend certain improvements; requiring the Board, beginning 9 on a certain date, to annually report its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Lean 10 11 Government Advisory Board.

- 2 (C) "LEAN" MEANS A BUSINESS-ORIENTED SYSTEM FOR ORGANIZING AND
- 3 MANAGING PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT, OPERATIONS, SUPPLIERS, AND CUSTOMER
- 4 RELATIONS TO CREATE PRECISE CUSTOMER VALUE, EXPRESSED AS PROVIDING
- 5 GOODS AND SERVICES WITH HIGHER QUALITY AND FEWER DEFECTS AND ERRORS
- 6 WITH LESS HUMAN EFFORT, LESS SPACE, LESS CAPITAL, AND LESS TIME THAN MORE
- 7 TRADITIONAL SYSTEMS.

- 20 (20) ONE INDIVIDUAL WITH EXPERTISE IN LEAN PRINCIPLES,
- 21 APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.
- 22 (C) THE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR SERVES AT THE
- 23 PLEASURE OF THE GOVERNOR AND SHALL CHAIR THE BOARD.
- 24 (D) THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT SHALL PROVIDE
- 25 STAFF FOR THE BOARD.
- 26 (E) A MEMBER OF THE BOARD:
- 27 (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD;
- 28 **BUT**

- IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE 1 **(2)** 2STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET. 9-3303. 3 THE BOARD SHALL: 4 **(1)** 5 MEET AT LEAST QUARTERLY; AND **(2)** 6 APPLY LEAN PRINCIPLES TO: ANALYZE THE OPERATIONS AND ORGANIZATION OF STATE 7 **(I)** 8 GOVERNMENT; 9 (II) IDENTIFY INEFFICIENCIES IN STATE **GOVERNMENT** 10 **OPERATIONS; AND** (III) RECOMMEND IMPROVEMENTS THAT WILL INCREASE STATE 11 GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY AND IMPROVE THE DELIVERY OF STATE GOVERNMENT 12 13 SERVICES. 14 9-3304.
- BEGINNING DECEMBER 1, 2018, AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE BOARD 15 SHALL REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS, INCLUDING ANY PROPOSED 16 LEGISLATION, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF 17 18 THIS ARTICLE.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2017.
