#### A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### Education - Selection of Members to the Baltimore County School Board

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Governor from appointing certain individuals as 4 members to the Baltimore County Board of Education in an election year; prohibiting 5 certain individuals from seeking appointment as members of the county board in an 6 election year; requiring the Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission 7 to hold a certain number of meetings, each in a separate councilmanic district, each 8 year; requiring the Commission, instead of the Governor, to appoint the chair of the 9 Commission; repealing the Governor's authority to reappoint the chair of the Commission; altering the terms of certain appointed members of the county board; 10 11 requiring the Commission to convene its first meeting on a certain date; and 12 generally relating to the membership of the Baltimore County Board of Education.

7 8	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
9	Article - Education
10	3–2A–01.
11	(a) The Baltimore County Board of Education consists of:
12	(1) Seven nonpartisan elected members;
13	(2) Four appointed members; and
14	(3) One student member.
15	(b) (5) DURING AN ELECTION YEAR:
16 17 18	(I) THE GOVERNOR MAY NOT APPOINT AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD AN INDIVIDUAL WHO FILES A CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY FOR ELECTION TO THE COUNTY BOARD; AND
19 20 21 22	(II) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO FILES A CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY FOR ELECTION TO THE COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT SEEK APPOINTMENT TO THE COUNTY BOARD BY THE GOVERNOR THROUGH NOMINATION BY THE BALTIMORE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING COMMISSION.

24	(a) (1) There is a Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission.
25 26 27	(2) The purpose of the Commission is to select nominees to be recommended to the Governor as qualified candidates for appointment to the Baltimore County Board of Education.
28 29	(3) The Commission shall hold at least [two] THREE public hearings, EACH IN A DIFFERENT COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT, on the selection of nominees before

recommending to the Governor nominees for appointment to the county board.

- 1 (c) (1) The [Governor] **COMMISSION** shall designate **ONE OF ITS MEMBERS**2 as chair of the Commission [one of the eight members appointed by the Governor under
  3 subsection (b)(3) of this section] **BY MAJORITY VOTE**.
- 4 (2) The term of the chair of the Commission is 4 years.
- 5 [(3) The Governor may reappoint the chair of the Commission for a second 6 term.]
- 7 [(4)] (3) The term of a member of the Commission is 4 years.

- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the appointed 10 members of the Baltimore County Board of Education shall expire as follows:
- 11 The terms of the four members appointed at large who are in office on the 12 effective date of this Act shall expire [as follows:] AT THE END OF DECEMBER 2, 2018, 13 AND THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT FOUR MEMBERS FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE BALTIMORE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING 14 COMMISSION AS ESTABLISHED UNDER § 3–2A–03 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE TO 15 16 SUCCEED THOSE FOUR DEPARTING MEMBERS, EACH TO SERVE FOR A TERM OF 4 17 YEARS BEGINNING ON DECEMBER 3, 2018, UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND 18 QUALIFIES.
- [(1) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2015, shall expire at the end of December 6, 2015, and the Governor shall appoint a member to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 7, 2015, until a successor is appointed and qualifies;
  - (2) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2016, shall expire at the end of December 4, 2016, and the Governor shall appoint a member to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 5, 2016, until a successor is appointed and qualifies; and
- 27 (3) the terms of the two members whose terms are scheduled to expire on June 30, 2018, shall expire at the end of December 2, 2018, and the Governor shall appoint two members from a list of nominees submitted by the Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission as established by Section 1 of this Act to succeed those two departing members, each to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 3, 2018, until a successor is appointed and qualifies.]
  - (b) The terms of the seven members appointed from councilmanic districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Baltimore County, or their successors, who are in office on June 1, 2016, shall terminate at the end of December 2, 2018, and the members elected from those councilmanic/school board districts in Baltimore County at the general election in

1 November 2018, shall succeed those appointed members and serve for a term of 4 years 2

beginning on December 3, 2018, until a successor is elected and qualifies.

### Chapter 481 of the Acts of 2014

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the appointed members of the Baltimore County Board of Education shall expire as follows:

- (a) The terms of the four members appointed at large who are in office on the effective date of this Act shall expire [as follows:] AT THE END OF DECEMBER 2, 2018, AND THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT FOUR MEMBERS FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE BALTIMORE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING COMMISSION AS ESTABLISHED UNDER § 3–2A–03 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE TO SUCCEED THOSE FOUR DEPARTING MEMBERS, EACH TO SERVE FOR A TERM OF 4 YEARS BEGINNING ON DECEMBER 3, 2018, UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- 14 the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 15 2015, shall expire at the end of December 6, 2015, and the Governor shall appoint a member 16 to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 7, 2015, until 17 a successor is appointed and qualifies;
- 18 (2)the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 19 2016, shall expire at the end of December 4, 2016, and the Governor shall appoint a member 20 to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 5, 2016, until 21 a successor is appointed and qualifies; and
- 22the terms of the two members whose terms are scheduled to expire on 23June 30, 2018, shall expire at the end of December 2, 2018, and the Governor shall appoint 24two members from a list of nominees submitted by the Baltimore County School Board 25 Nominating Commission as established by Section 1 of this Act to succeed those two 26 departing members, each to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 3, 2018, 27 until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 28 The terms of the seven members appointed from councilmanic districts 1, 2, 293, 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Baltimore County, or their successors, who are in office on June 1, 2016, 30 shall terminate at the end of December 2, 2018, and the members elected from those 31 councilmanic/school board districts in Baltimore County at the general election in 32 November 2018, shall succeed those appointed members and serve for a term of 4 years 33 beginning on December 3, 2018, until a successor is elected and qualifies.
- 34 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Baltimore County School 35 Board Nominating Commission shall first convene on October 1, 2017, to begin preparing 36 its first set of recommendations to the Governor.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
