1 AN ACT concerning

2 Education – Selection of Members to the Baltimore County School Board

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Governor from appointing certain individuals as 4 members to the Baltimore County Board of Education in an election year; prohibiting $\mathbf{5}$ certain individuals from seeking appointment as members of the county board in an 6 election year; requiring the Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission 7 to hold a certain number of meetings, each in a separate councilmanic district, each 8 year; requiring the Commission, instead of the Governor, to appoint the chair of the 9 Commission; repealing the Governor's authority to reappoint the chair of the 10 Commission; altering the terms of certain appointed members of the county board; 11 requiring the Commission to convene its first meeting on a certain date; and 12 generally relating to the membership of the Baltimore County Board of Education.

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1 (2) The purpose of the Commission is to select nominees to be 2 recommended to the Governor as qualified candidates for appointment to the Baltimore 3 County Board of Education.

4 (3) The Commission shall hold at least [two] THREE public hearings, 5 EACH IN A DIFFERENT COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT, on the selection of nominees before 6 recommending to the Governor nominees for appointment to the county board.

7 (c) (1) The [Governor] **COMMISSION** shall designate **ONE OF ITS MEMBERS** 8 as chair of the Commission [one of the eight members appointed by the Governor under 9 subsection (b)(3) of this section] **BY MAJORITY VOTE**.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the appointed 16 members of the Baltimore County Board of Education shall expire as follows:

17(a) The terms of the four members appointed at large who are in office on the effective date of this Act, OR THE TERMS OF THEIR SUCCESSORS, shall expire [as 18 follows:] AT THE END OF DECEMBER 2, 2018, AND THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT 19 20FOUR MEMBERS FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE BALTIMORE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING COMMISSION AS ESTABLISHED UNDER § 21223-2A-03 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE TO SUCCEED THOSE FOUR DEPARTING 23MEMBERS, EACH TO SERVE FOR A TERM OF 4 YEARS BEGINNING ON DECEMBER 3, 24**2018, UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.**

[(1) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 26 2015, shall expire at the end of December 6, 2015, and the Governor shall appoint a member 27 to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 7, 2015, until 28 a successor is appointed and qualifies;

29 (2) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 30 2016, shall expire at the end of December 4, 2016, and the Governor shall appoint a member 31 to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 5, 2016, until 32 a successor is appointed and qualifies; and

(3) the terms of the two members whose terms are scheduled to expire on
 June 30, 2018, shall expire at the end of December 2, 2018, and the Governor shall appoint
 two members from a list of nominees submitted by the Baltimore County School Board

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Nominating Commission as established by Section 1 of this Act to succeed those two
departing members, each to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 3, 2018,
until a successor is appointed and qualifies.]

4 (b) The terms of the seven members appointed from councilmanic districts 1, 2, 5 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Baltimore County, or their successors, who are in office on June 1, 2016, 6 shall terminate at the end of December 2, 2018, and the members elected from those 7 councilmanic/school board districts in Baltimore County at the general election in 8 November 2018, shall succeed those appointed members and serve for a term of 4 years 9 beginning on December 3, 2018, until a successor is elected and qualifies.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the appointed 12 members of the Baltimore County Board of Education shall expire as follows:

13(a) The terms of the four members appointed at large who are in office on the 14effective date of this Act, OR THE TERMS OF THEIR SUCCESSORS, shall expire [as follows:] AT THE END OF DECEMBER 2, 2018, AND THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT 15FOUR MEMBERS FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE BALTIMORE 16 17COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING COMMISSION AS ESTABLISHED UNDER § 18 3-2A-03 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE TO SUCCEED THOSE FOUR DEPARTING MEMBERS, EACH TO SERVE FOR A TERM OF 4 YEARS BEGINNING ON DECEMBER 3. 19 20**2018, UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.**

[(1) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2015, shall expire at the end of December 6, 2015, and the Governor shall appoint a member 23 to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 7, 2015, until 24 a successor is appointed and qualifies;

(2) the term of the member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30,
2016, shall expire at the end of December 4, 2016, and the Governor shall appoint a member
to succeed that member to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 5, 2016, until
a successor is appointed and qualifies; and

(3) the terms of the two members whose terms are scheduled to expire on June 30, 2018, shall expire at the end of December 2, 2018, and the Governor shall appoint two members from a list of nominees submitted by the Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission as established by Section 1 of this Act to succeed those two departing members, each to serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 3, 2018, until a successor is appointed and qualifies.]

35 (b) The terms of the seven members appointed from councilmanic districts 1, 2, 36 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Baltimore County, or their successors, who are in office on June 1, 2016, 37 shall terminate at the end of December 2, 2018, and the members elected from those 38 councilmanic/school board districts in Baltimore County at the general election in

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November 2018, shall succeed those appointed members and serve for a term of 4 years
 beginning on December 3, 2018, until a successor is elected and qualifies.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Baltimore County School
 Board Nominating Commission shall first convene on October 1, 2017, to begin preparing
 its first set of recommendations to the Governor.

6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2017.
