- 2 (a) To qualify for a real estate appraisal license, an applicant shall be an 3 individual who meets the requirements of this section.
- 4 (b) An applicant shall be of good character and reputation.
- 5 (c) An applicant shall be at least 18 years old.
- 6 (d) (1) An applicant shall satisfy the minimum real estate appraiser qualifications for licensure established under the federal Financial Institutions Reform, 8 Recovery, and Enforcement Act of 1989.
- 9 (2) An applicant shall have completed at least 2,000 hours providing real estate appraiser services as a real estate appraiser trainee under the supervision of a [licensed or] certified appraiser.

- 13 (a) To qualify for a certificate for residential or general real estate appraisal, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.
- (b) (1) An applicant shall:
- 16 (i) be of good character and reputation;
- 17 (ii) be at least 18 years old; and
- 18 (iii) satisfy the minimum real estate appraiser qualifications for 19 residential certification or general certification, as appropriate, established under the 20 federal Financial Institutions Reform, Recovery, and Enforcement Act of 1989.
- 21 (2) An applicant shall have completed at least 2,000 hours providing real estate appraiser services as a real estate appraiser trainee under the supervision of a [licensed or] certified appraiser.
