1 AN ACT concerning

State Board of Nursing – Registered Nurses and Licensed Practical Nurses – Renewal of Licenses – Continuing Education Units

FOR the purpose of altering the requirements for renewing certain licenses by authorizing certain registered nurses and licensed practical nurses to renew a license if the registered nurse or licensed practical nurse submits to the State Board of Nursing certain evidence of completion of a certain number of continuing education units as required by regulations adopted by the Board; and generally relating to the renewal of licenses of registered nurses and licensed practical nurses.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 (c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an 20 additional term, if the licensee:

- 21 (1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
- 22 (2) Pays to the Board:
- 23 (i) A renewal fee set by the Board; or



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$rac{1}{2}$	(ii) A renewal fee that is set by the Board if the licensee certifies to the Board that the licensee provides professional services only as a volunteer; and
3	(3) Submits to the Board by paper application or electronic means:
4	(i) A renewal application on the form that the Board requires; and
5	(ii) Satisfactory evidence of completion of:
6 7	1. 1,000 hours of active nursing practice within the 5-year period immediately preceding the date of renewal;
8 9	2. A course of instruction, commonly known as a refresher course, approved by the Board; [or]
10 11	3. A preceptorship program provided by an employer and approved by the Board; OR
12 13	4. A MINIMUM NUMBER OF CONTINUING EDUCATION UNITS AS REQUIRED BY REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD.
