2 State Government – Closed Captioning Activation Required Without Request

- FOR the purpose of requiring places of public accommodation to keep closed captioning
 activated on certain television receivers under certain circumstances regardless of
 whether the closed captioning was requested; and generally relating to activation of
 closed captioning on television receivers in places of public accommodation.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – State Government

- 15 20–306.
- 16 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 17 (2) "Closed captioning" means a transcript or dialog of the audio portion of 18 a television program that is displayed on a television receiver screen when the user 19 activates the feature.
- (3) "Closed-captioning television receiver" means a receiver of television
 programming that has the ability to display closed captioning, including a television, digital
 set top box, and any other technology capable of displaying closed captioning.



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1 (4) "Public area" means a part of a place of public accommodation that is 2 open to the general public.

3 (5) "Regular hours" means the hours of any day in which a place of public 4 accommodation is open to members of the general public.

5 (b) [On request, a] A place of public accommodation may not fail to keep closed 6 captioning activated on any closed-captioning television receiver that is in use during 7 regular hours in any public area.

8 (c) This section does not require a place of public accommodation to make closed 9 captioning available in a public area of the place of public accommodation if:

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(1) no television receiver of any kind is available in the public area; or

11 (2) the only public television receiver available in the public area is not a 12 closed–captioning television receiver.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 October 1, 2017.
