Washington Metrorail Safety Commission Membership Act

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain members of the board of directors of the Washington Metrorail Safety Commission be appointed by the Governor with the 4 $\mathbf{5}$ advice and consent of the Senate; requiring one regular member of the board of 6 directors of the Commission who is appointed by the Governor to be a resident of 7 Montgomery County or Prince George's County; providing that the regular member 8 of the board of directors of the Commission who is a resident of Montgomery County 9 or Prince George's County may not be succeeded by an individual who is a resident 10 of the same county; making this Act contingent on the taking effect of another Act; 11 and generally relating to the membership of the Washington Metrorail Safety 12Commission.

1 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "COMMISSION" MEANS THE WASHINGTON 2 METRORAIL SAFETY COMMISSION ESTABLISHED UNDER § 10–208 OF THIS ARTICLE.

3 (B) TWO REGULAR MEMBERS AND ONE ALTERNATE MEMBER OF THE BOARD
4 OF DIRECTORS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR
5 WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.

6 (C) (1) ONE OF THE REGULAR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS 7 OF THE COMMISSION WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR SHALL BE A RESIDENT 8 OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY OR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.

9 (2) THE INDIVIDUAL APPOINTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT 10 BE SUCCEEDED IN OFFICE BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE SAME 11 COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 13 1, 2017, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter ____ (S.B. __/H.B. ___) (7lr0013) of the 14 Acts of the General Assembly of 2017, and if Chapter ____ (S.B. __/H.B. ___) (7lr0013) does 15 not become effective, this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action 16 by the General Assembly.
