# Health Insurance – Licensed Clinical Professional Art Therapists – Reimbursement

FOR the purpose of adding a licensed clinical professional art therapist to the types of
licensed clinical counselors and therapists whose services entitle an insured or
certain other persons to reimbursement, under certain circumstances, under certain
health insurance policies, contracts, or certificates; and generally relating to health

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 17 Article – Insurance

18 15-704.

19 (a) This section applies to each individual, group, or blanket health insurance 20 policy, contract, or certificate of an insurer or nonprofit health service plan that:

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1 (1) (i) is delivered or issued for delivery in the State;

2 (ii) is issued to a group that is incorporated or has a main office in 3 the State; or

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- (iii) covers individuals who reside or work in the State; and
- (2) is issued, renewed, amended, or reissued on or after October 1, 2003.

6 (b) If a policy, contract, or certificate subject to this section provides for 7 reimbursement for a service that is within the lawful scope of practice of a licensed clinical 8 professional counselor, a licensed clinical marriage and family therapist, [or] a licensed 9 clinical alcohol and drug counselor, OR A LICENSED CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL ART 10 THERAPIST, the insured or any other person covered by the policy or certificate is entitled 11 to reimbursement for the service.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2017.
