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## Montgomery County – Beer, Wine, and Liquor Festival License

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# MC 7–17

4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Beer, Wine, and Liquor Festival license in Montgomery  $\mathbf{5}$ County; authorizing a certain festival organization to conduct a beer, wine, and 6 liquor festival under the supervision of the Montgomery County Department of 7 Liquor Control; specifying certain conditions under which beer, wine, or liquor may 8 be displayed and sold on or off the festival premises at certain times; requiring a 9 festival organization to choose festival weekends and location and ensure that the 10 primary focus of the festival is the promotion of Maryland beer, wine, or liquor; 11 authorizing a festival organization to contract with holders of certain alcoholic 12beverages licenses to sell and display beer, wine, or liquor at the festival; allowing 13 certain persons to hold a festival license in addition to another license; establishing 14 a license fee; requiring certain license fees to be deposited into the general fund of 15Montgomery County; establishing certain penalties; requiring the Montgomery 16County Board of License Commissioners to adopt certain regulations; defining 17certain terms; repealing certain provisions of law concerning beer festival licenses 18 and wine festival licenses that are rendered duplicative by this Act; and generally 19relating to a beer, wine, and liquor festival in Montgomery County.

8 (J) (1) THE BOARD MAY DENY A BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FESTIVAL 9 LICENSE TO AN APPLICANT OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE A BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR 10 FESTIVAL LICENSE IF THE APPLICANT OR LICENSE HOLDER VIOLATES A PROVISION 11 OF THIS ARTICLE OR THE REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD.

12 (2) INSTEAD OF OR IN ADDITION TO DENYING, SUSPENDING, OR 13 REVOKING A LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD MAY IMPOSE ON AN 14 APPLICANT OR LICENSE HOLDER A FINE NOT EXCEEDING **\$20,000**.

15 (K) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

16 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 17 1, 2017.
