Baltimore City – Public Art – Verification of Location by Legislative Auditor <u>Report on Identification, Protection, and Maintenance</u>

FOR the purpose of requiring that Baltimore City include with a certain financial report 4 an inventory of all public art owned by Baltimore City; requiring that the Legislative $\mathbf{5}$ 6 Auditor each year verify that each piece of public art included in the inventory is at 7 the location specified in the inventory; defining a certain term; the City of Baltimore and the Baltimore City Public School System to report to the Baltimore City 8 9 delegation to the General Assembly on or before a certain date on the status of the 10 implementation of certain recommendations concerning the identification, 11 protection, and maintenance of public art located on certain campuses and within certain buildings; and generally relating to the verification of the location 12 13identification, protection, and maintenance of public art owned by Baltimore City.

17 That, on or before December 1, 2017, the City of Baltimore and the Baltimore City Public 18 School System shall report to the members of the Baltimore City delegation to the General 19 Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on the status of 20 the implementation of the recommendations contained in the City of Baltimore Office of 21 the Inspector General's March 4, 2016 report (OIG Report #2014–0338) concerning the 22 identification, protection, and maintenance of public art located on campuses and within 23 buildings of the City of Baltimore and the Baltimore City Public School System.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 October June 1, 2017.
