## 1 AN ACT concerning

## Food Service Facilities – Automated External Defibrillator Program (The Joe Sheya Act)

FOR the purpose of requiring the owner and operator of a certain food service facility to
develop and, beginning on a certain date, implement an automated external
defibrillator program that meets certain requirements; requiring the Department of
Health and Mental Hygiene and the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical
Services Systems jointly to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to an
automated external defibrillator program for food service facilities.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 (B) THE OWNER AND OPERATOR OF A FOOD SERVICE FACILITY SHALL 2 DEVELOP AND, BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2018, IMPLEMENT AN AUTOMATED 3 EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR PROGRAM THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 4 13-517 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

5 (C) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE AND THE 6 MARYLAND INSTITUTE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SYSTEMS JOINTLY 7 SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT:

8 (1) ESTABLISH GUIDELINES FOR PERIODIC INSPECTIONS AND 9 ANNUAL MAINTENANCE OF THE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS; AND

10(2)ASSIST THE OWNER AND OPERATOR OF A FOOD SERVICE FACILITY11IN CARRYING OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2017.
