Vehicle Laws - Bicycles - Use of Crosswalks

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a person to ride a bicycle in or through a crosswalk in a 4 place where a person may not lawfully ride a bicycle on a sidewalk or sidewalk area; 5 providing that a person riding a bicycle in or through a crosswalk is subject to certain 6 traffic control signals; prohibiting a person riding a bicycle in or through a crosswalk 7 from suddenly leaving the curb or other place of safety and moving into the path of 8 a certain vehicle in a certain manner; requiring the driver of a vehicle to come to a 9 stop for a bicycle crossing the roadway in a crosswalk under certain circumstances; 10 prohibiting the driver of a certain vehicle from overtaking or passing a vehicle that 11 is stopped to let a bicycle cross the roadway at a certain crosswalk; defining a certain 12 term; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to the use of crosswalks by 13 bicycles.

- 24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 25 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

- 2 21–1103.
- 3 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), (c), or (d) of this section, a person may 4 not drive any vehicle on a sidewalk or sidewalk area unless it is a permanent or authorized 5 temporary driveway.
- 6 (b) (1) For the purposes of this subsection, "bicycle" does not include ["moped", 7 as defined in § 11–134.1 of this article] A MOPED.
- 8 (2) Where allowed by local ordinance, a person may ride a bicycle, play 9 vehicle, or unicycle on a sidewalk or sidewalk area.
- [(3) In a place where a person may ride a bicycle on a sidewalk or sidewalk area, a person may also ride a bicycle from the curb or edge of the roadway in or through a crosswalk to the opposite curb or edge of the roadway.]
- 13 (c) Unless prohibited by local ordinance, an individual with a disability may use 14 a special vehicle other than a wheelchair on sidewalks or sidewalk areas.
- 15 (d) An individual may use a wheelchair on sidewalks or sidewalk areas in accordance with $\S 21-501.1$ of this title.

- 18 (A) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "BICYCLE" DOES NOT INCLUDE A 19 MOPED.
- 20 (B) A PERSON MAY RIDE A BICYCLE FROM THE CURB OR EDGE OF A 21 ROADWAY IN OR THROUGH THE CROSSWALK TO THE OPPOSITE CURB OR EDGE OF 22 THE ROADWAY.
- 23 (C) A PERSON RIDING A BICYCLE IN OR THROUGH A CROSSWALK:
- 24 (1) IS SUBJECT TO ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS, AS PROVIDED IN 25 §\$ 21–202 AND 21–203 OF THIS TITLE; AND
- 26 (2) MAY NOT SUDDENLY LEAVE THE CURB OR OTHER PLACE OF SAFETY AND MOVE INTO THE PATH OF A VEHICLE THAT IS SO CLOSE THAT IT IS IMPOSSIBLE FOR THE DRIVER TO YIELD.
- 29 (D) (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY WHERE:

1	((I)	A	PEDESTRIAN	TUNNEL	OR	OVERHEAD	PEDESTRIAN
2	CROSSING IS PROVIDED, AS DESCRIBED IN § 21–503(B) OF THIS TITLE; OR							

- 3 (II) A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL IS IN OPERATION.
- 4 (2) THE DRIVER OF A VEHICLE SHALL COME TO A STOP WHEN A 5 BICYCLE CROSSING THE ROADWAY IN A CROSSWALK IS:
- 6 (I) ON THE HALF OF THE ROADWAY ON WHICH THE VEHICLE IS 7 TRAVELING; OR
- 8 (II) APPROACHING FROM AN ADJACENT LANE ON THE OTHER 9 HALF OF THE ROADWAY.
- 10 **(E)** IF, AT A MARKED CROSSWALK OR AN UNMARKED CROSSWALK AT AN INTERSECTION, A VEHICLE IS STOPPED TO LET A BICYCLE CROSS THE ROADWAY, THE DRIVER OF ANY OTHER VEHICLE APPROACHING FROM THE REAR MAY NOT OVERTAKE AND PASS THE STOPPED VEHICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
