A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

St. Mary's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Beauty Salon License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing in St. Mary's County a beauty salon beer and wine license; 4 authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the license to a person who $\mathbf{5}$ holds a beauty salon permit and operates a beauty salon; authorizing a holder of the 6 license to sell or serve not more than a certain amount of beer and wine for 7 on-premises consumption by a beauty salon customer under certain circumstances; 8 prohibiting the license from being transferred to another location; establishing 9 certain hours during which beer and wine may be provided; specifying that an establishment for which the license is issued is subject to certain alcohol awareness 1011 training requirements; establishing a certain license fee; and generally relating to 12alcoholic beverages licenses in St. Mary's County.

24 (D) THE LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER LOCATION.

25 (E) A HOLDER OF THE LICENSE MAY SELL OR SERVE BEER AND WINE FOR 26 ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS BUT NOT LATER 27 THAN 9 P.M.

28 (F) AN ESTABLISHMENT FOR WHICH THE LICENSE IS ISSUED IS SUBJECT TO 29 THE ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 4–505 OF THIS 30 ARTICLE.

31 (G) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$300.
