# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article – State Government

15 10-1201.

Each unit of State government shall install and maintain a telephone system that allows a person from anywhere in the State to communicate with employees of the unit by [toll-free] telephone call during the regular business hours of the unit for the purpose of conducting official State business.

Each unit of State government shall print [its toll-free] THE telephone numbers PROVIDED FOR UNDER § 10–1201 OF THIS SUBTITLE on the unit's official documents,

1 including stationery, fax cover sheets, business cards, and other publications that are2 distributed to the public.

3 10-1203.

Each unit shall include [each of its toll-free] THE telephone numbers PROVIDED FOR UNDER § 10-1201 OF THIS SUBTITLE in any directory that lists information about the unit.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2017.
