- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 (3) (I) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL MANAGE THE STAFF OF 2 THE BOARD AND PERFORM ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS TO CARRY OUT THE 3 POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD AS PROVIDED FOR UNDER THIS TITLE.

4 (II) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MAY NOT DIRECTLY CONDUCT 5 INSPECTIONS ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 7 1, 2017.
