4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain health occupations boards to comply with certain $\mathbf{5}$ provisions of this Act before submitting a proposed regulation to the Joint Committee 6 on Administrative, Executive, and Legislative Review or adopting a new policy 7 interpretation of an existing regulation; requiring each health occupations board to 8 send certain regulations or policy interpretations to each licensee or certificate 9 holder of the board by certain means and to a certain address; requiring each health 10 occupations board to request the licensee or certificate holder to contact the board 11 with certain questions or concerns within a certain period of time; requiring certain 12health occupations boards to hold a public meeting to discuss certain questions and 13 concerns at least a certain number of days after sending a proposed regulation or policy interpretation to a licensee or certificate holder; providing for the application 14 15of this Act: and generally relating to health occupations boards and requirements 16relating to proposed regulations and new policy interpretations.

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(A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN EMERGENCY REGULATION.

2 **(B)** EACH HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A LICENSE 3 OR CERTIFICATE UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION BEFORE:

4 (1) SUBMITTING A PROPOSED REGULATION TO THE JOINT 5 COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATIVE, EXECUTIVE, AND LEGISLATIVE REVIEW IN 6 ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT; OR

7 (2) ADOPTING A NEW POLICY INTERPRETATION OF AN EXISTING 8 REGULATION.

9 (C) EACH HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD SHALL:

10(1)SENDAPROPOSEDREGULATIONORNEWPOLICY11INTERPRETATION TO EACH LICENSEE OR CERTIFICATE HOLDER OF THE BOARD BY12ELECTRONIC MEANS OR FIRST-CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ELECTRONIC OR13PHYSICAL ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE OR CERTIFICATE HOLDER; AND

14 (2) REQUEST THAT THE LICENSEE OR CERTIFICATE HOLDER 15 CONTACT THE BOARD WITH ANY QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS REGARDING THE 16 PROPOSED REGULATION OR NEW POLICY INTERPRETATION WITHIN 14 DAYS AFTER 17 THE DATE THE PROPOSED REGULATION OR NEW POLICY INTERPRETATION WAS 18 SENT.

(D) AT LEAST 30 DAYS AFTER SENDING A PROPOSED REGULATION OR NEW
POLICY INTERPRETATION AS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION,
THE BOARD SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS ANY QUESTIONS OR
CONCERNS RECEIVED BY THE BOARD.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2017.

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
