7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 8 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary 9 or compensation of the Sheriff of St. Mary's County, the County Treasurer of St. Mary's 10 County, or the State's Attorney for St. Mary's County while serving in a term of office 11 beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of St. Mary's County, the County Treasurer of St. 12Mary's County, and the State's Attorney for St. Mary's County shall take effect at the 1314beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term. 15

16 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 October 1, 2017.
