### 1 AN ACT concerning

# State Board of Dental Examiners – Death of a Licensed Dentist – Ownership of a Dental Practice

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing, under certain circumstances, an heir or a personal  $\mathbf{5}$ representative of a deceased licensed dentist who was the owner of a dental practice 6 to serve as an owner of the dental practice for a certain period of time; authorizing 7 the State Board of Dental Examiners to extend a certain time period under certain 8 circumstances; requiring that all patient care be provided by certain individuals and 9 in accordance with certain scopes of practice during the temporary ownership of a 10 dental practice by an heir or a representative of a deceased licensed dentist; 11 prohibiting the temporary ownership of a dental practice by an heir or a 12 representative of a deceased licensed dentist to affect the exercise of independent 13 judgment by certain licensed dentists; and generally relating to the death of a 14licensed dentist and the ownership of the practice of the licensed dentist.

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SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## Article – Health Occupations

4 4-301.

5 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this title, an individual shall be 6 licensed by the Board to practice dentistry before the individual may practice dentistry on 7 a human being in this State.

8 (2) Except as otherwise provided in this title, an individual shall be 9 licensed by the Board to practice dental hygiene before the individual may practice dental 10 hygiene on a human being in this State.

11 (b) This section does not apply to:

12 (1) A student of dentistry while engaged in an educational program at an 13 approved school of dentistry;

14 (2) A student of dental hygiene while engaged in an approved educational 15 program in dental hygiene;

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(3) A dentist while performing official duties in a federal dental service;

17 (4) An individual licensed to practice dentistry in any other state or a 18 foreign country, while the individual:

19 (i) Makes a clinical demonstration before a dental society, dental 20 convention, association of dentists, or dental college; or

21 (ii) Performs professional duties on a specific case for which the 22 individual is called into this State; [or]

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(5) A dental assistant, if the dental assistant:

(i) Subject to the rules and regulations adopted by the Board,
 performs only procedures that do not require the professional skills of a licensed dentist;
 and

(ii) Performs intraoral tasks only under the direct supervision of a
licensed dentist who personally is present in the office area where the tasks are performed;
OR

30 (6) AN HEIR OF A DECEASED LICENSED DENTIST OR A PERSONAL 31 REPRESENTATIVE OF A DECEASED LICENSED DENTIST, IF:

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1 (I) THE DECEASED LICENSED DENTIST WAS THE OWNER OF 2 THE DENTAL PRACTICE;

3 (II) THE DECEASED LICENSED DENTIST DID NOT PROVIDE FOR
 4 THE DISPOSITION OF THE DENTAL PRACTICE; AND

5 (III) THE HEIR OR THE PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE 6 DECEASED LICENSED DENTIST SERVES AS THE OWNER OF THE DENTAL PRACTICE, 7 REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE HEIR OR THE PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE IS 8 LICENSED TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY, FOR NO LONGER THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE 9 DEATH OF THE LICENSED DENTIST UNLESS THE BOARD EXTENDS THE TIME PERIOD 10 UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(1) OF THIS SECTION.

11 **(C)** (1) ON WRITTEN REQUEST AND GOOD CAUSE SHOWN BY THE HEIR OR 12PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE OF A DECEASED LICENSED DENTIST, INCLUDING 13EVIDENCE OF A GOOD FAITH EFFORT TO SELL OR CLOSE THE DENTAL PRACTICE, THE BOARD, IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION, MAY EXTEND THE 1-YEAR PERIOD UNDER 14SUBSECTION (B)(6)(III) OF THIS SECTION FOR UP TO AN ADDITIONAL 6 MONTHS TO 1516ALLOW THE HEIR OR PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE SUFFICIENT TIME TO SELL OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF THE DENTAL PRACTICE. 17

18 (2) DURING THE TEMPORARY OWNERSHIP OF A DENTAL PRACTICE BY 19 AN HEIR OR A REPRESENTATIVE OF A DECEASED LICENSED DENTIST UNDER 20 SUBSECTION (B)(6)(III) OF THIS SECTION AND, IF APPLICABLE, PARAGRAPH (1) OF 21 THIS SUBSECTION, ALL PATIENT CARE SHALL BE PROVIDED:

22(I)BY AN APPROPRIATE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED UNDER23THIS TITLE; AND

24 (II) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INDIVIDUAL'S SCOPE OF 25 PRACTICE.

(3) THE TEMPORARY OWNERSHIP OF A DENTAL PRACTICE BY AN HEIR
 OR A PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE OF A DECEASED LICENSED DENTIST UNDER THIS
 SUBSECTION MAY NOT AFFECT THE EXERCISE OF THE INDEPENDENT JUDGMENT OF
 A LICENSED DENTIST WHO PROVIDES CARE TO PATIENTS OF THE DENTAL PRACTICE.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 31 1, 2017.
