17 (a) A permit expires on the last day of the holder's birth month following [2] 5 18 years after the date the permit is issued.

19 (b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, a permit may be renewed for 20 successive periods of [3] 5 years each if, at the time of an application for renewal, the 21 applicant possesses the qualifications for the issuance of a permit and pays the renewal fee 22 stated in this subtitle.

1 (c) A person who applies for a renewal of a permit is not required to be 2 fingerprinted unless the Secretary requires a set of the person's fingerprints to resolve a 3 question of the person's identity.
