- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

17 **BEFORE THE SECRETARY APPROVES THE AMENDMENT OR RENEWAL OF A** 18 **PERMIT FOR A REFUSE DISPOSAL SYSTEM, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:**

- 19(1) PROVIDE NOTICE OF THE PERMIT AMENDMENT OR RENEWAL IN20ACCORDANCE WITH § 1–602 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND
- 21 (2) HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PERMIT AMENDMENT OR 22 RENEWAL.
