- 20 (a) On or before July 1, 2016, the Board shall require a certificate holder applying for renewal of a certificate as a school counselor to have obtained **TRAINING IN**, by a method determined by the Board, the knowledge and skills required to understand and respond to the social, emotional, and personal development of students, including knowledge and skills relating to:
- 25 (1) The recognition of indicators of mental illness and behavioral distress, 26 including depression, trauma, violence, youth suicide, and substance abuse; and
- 27 (2) The identification of professional resources to help students in crisis.
- 28 (B) THE TRAINING REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 29 SHALL BE COMMENSURATE WITH THE DUTIES OF A SCHOOL COUNSELOR AND MAY 30 EXCEED THE TRAINING REQUIRED OF OTHER SCHOOL PERSONNEL UNDER § 6–122 31 OF THIS TITLE.
