Primary and Secondary Education - School Personnel - Training Requirement

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education to require, beginning on or 4 before a certain date, certain school personnel to complete training in, by a method 5 determined by each county board of education, certain knowledge and skills required 6 to understand and respond to the social, emotional, and personal development of 7 students; requiring certain training to be provided to certain school personnel during 8 in-service training or to be a professional development requirement; requiring the 9 State Board to adopt certain regulations; requiring certain training for certain certificate holders applying for renewal of a certificate as a school counselor to meet 10 11 a certain standard or exceed the standard of certain training required of other school 12 personnel; and generally relating to a training requirement for school personnel.

- 3 OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2018, THE STATE BOARD SHALL REQUIRE ALL SCHOOL
- 4 PERSONNEL TO COMPLETE TRAINING EACH YEAR, BY A METHOD DETERMINED BY
- 5 EACH COUNTY BOARD, IN THE SKILLS REQUIRED TO UNDERSTAND AND RESPOND TO
- 6 THE SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL, AND PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT OF STUDENTS, INCLUDING
- 7 KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS RELATING TO:
- 8 (1) THE RECOGNITION OF INDICATORS OF MENTAL ILLNESS AND

- 22 (a) On or before July 1, 2016, the Board shall require a certificate holder applying
- 23 for renewal of a certificate as a school counselor to have obtained TRAINING IN, by a method
- 24 determined by the Board, the knowledge and skills required to understand and respond to
- 25 the social, emotional, and personal development of students, including knowledge and skills
- 26 relating to:
- 27 (1) The recognition of indicators of mental illness and behavioral distress,
- 28 including depression, trauma, violence, youth suicide, and substance abuse; and
- 29 (2) The identification of professional resources to help students in crisis.
- 30 (B) THE TRAINING REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION
- 31 SHALL BE COMMENSURATE WITH THE DUTIES OF A SCHOOL COUNSELOR AND MAY

- 1 EXCEED THE TRAINING REQUIRED OF OTHER SCHOOL PERSONNEL UNDER § 6–122
- 2 OF THIS TITLE.
- 3 **[(b)] (C)** The Board shall adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this 4 section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 $\,$ 1, 2017.
