Education – Privately Contracted School Bus Drivers – Annual Physical Examination Requirement

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting an individual from operating a school bus for a private, nongovernmental entity under a contract with a local school system to transport pupils unless the individual completes an annual medical physical examination and submits a copy of the examination report to the individual's employer attesting that the individual's medical health is satisfactory; establishing a penalty; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to an annual medical physical examination for certain privately contracted school bus drivers.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 20 (A) If an individual meets all other requirements established by the State Board,
- 21 [he] THE INDIVIDUAL may not be prohibited from operating a school bus solely because of

- 1 (B) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT OPERATE A SCHOOL BUS FOR A PRIVATE,
  2 NONGOVERNMENTAL ENTITY UNDER A CONTRACT WITH A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM
- 3 TO TRANSPORT PUPILS UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL:
- 4 (1) COMPLETES AN ANNUAL MEDICAL PHYSICAL EXAMINATION TO 5 CONFIRM THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS PHYSICALLY FIT TO OPERATE A SCHOOL BUS; 6 AND
- 7 (2) SUBMITS A COPY OF THE ANNUAL MEDICAL PHYSICAL 8 EXAMINATION REPORT TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S EMPLOYER ATTESTING THAT THE 9 INDIVIDUAL'S MEDICAL CONDITION IS SATISFACTORY.
- 10 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS
  11 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT
  12 EXCEEDING \$5,000.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
