University System of Maryland – Constituent Institutions – Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery Program

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland, 5 on a certain recommendation from the Chancellor, to establish general standards 6 and guidelines for a collegiate recovery program to be implemented at the 7 constituent institutions; requiring the president of each constituent institution, in 8 collaboration with faculty, staff, and students enrolled at the institution, to develop 9 and implement a collegiate recovery program tailored for the institution; requiring that the program include certain features; defining a term; and generally relating to 10 11 a collegiate recovery program at constituent institutions of the University System of 12 Maryland.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Education
- 21 **12–117.**
- 22 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "COLLEGIATE RECOVERY PROGRAM" MEANS A
- 23 PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES SUPPORT AND SERVICES FOR STUDENTS RECOVERING
- 24 FROM ALCOHOL OR DRUG ADDICTION WHO ARE ENROLLED AT A CONSTITUENT
- 25 INSTITUTION.



- 1 (B) ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHANCELLOR, WHO SHALL CONSULT WITH THE PRESIDENTS OF THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS, THE BOARD OF REGENTS SHALL ESTABLISH GENERAL STANDARDS AND GUIDELINES FOR A COLLEGIATE RECOVERY PROGRAM TO BE IMPLEMENTED AT THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS.
- 6 (C) THE PRESIDENT OF EACH CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION, IN 7 COLLABORATION WITH FACULTY, STAFF, AND STUDENTS ENROLLED AT THE 8 INSTITUTION, SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A COLLEGIATE RECOVERY 9 PROGRAM TAILORED FOR THE INSTITUTION THAT:
- 10 (1) SATISFIES THE STANDARDS AND GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED BY 11 THE CHANCELLOR UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- 12 **(2)** ADDRESSES THE NEEDS OF STUDENTS AT THE INSTITUTION WHO 13 ARE RECOVERING FROM ALCOHOL OR DRUG ADDICTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
