15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 4 (2) (I) IN THIS PARAGRAPH, "DROP" MEANS THE DEFERRED 5 RETIREMENT OPTION PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER § 26–401.1 OF THIS 6 SUBTITLE.
- 7 (II) PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO 8 AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- 9 1. WHILE SERVING AS SHERIFF OF A COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY, BECOMES A MEMBER AS A RESULT OF EMPLOYMENT IN THAT SAME CAPACITY AS SHERIFF;
- 2. WHILE SERVING AS SHERIFF OF A COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY, JOINS THE DROP WHILE EMPLOYED IN THAT SAME CAPACITY AS SHERIFF;
- 3. TERMINATES MEMBERSHIP IN THE **DROP** PRIOR TO THE END OF THE MEMBER'S TERM OF OFFICE AS SHERIFF; AND
- 4. CONTINUES TO SERVE IN THE SAME CAPACITY AS SHERIFF AFTER TERMINATING MEMBERSHIP IN THE DROP.
