## Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

17 **6–412.** 

A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE SHALL HAVE STANDING TO FILE SUIT IN THE APPROPRIATE CIRCUIT COURT AGAINST AN ELECTED OFFICIAL WHO CREATES OR MAINTAINS A SANCTUARY PROGRAM IN VIOLATION OF THE FEDERAL IMMIGRATION AND NATIONALITY ACT FOR AN INJUNCTION AGAINST THE SANCTUARY PROGRAM.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2017.
