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Public School Employees - Required Training on Retirement Benefits

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to establish a training program for certain public school employees regarding certain available retirement 4 5 benefits; requiring the Department to offer the training to public school employees 6 at least once per year; requiring the Department to work in consultation with staff 7 from the State Retirement Agency and staff from the Maryland Supplemental 8 Retirement Plans to provide the training program; requiring public school employees 9 to attend the training each year and to provide written confirmation to the Department that the employee completed the training requirement; defining a 10 11 certain term; and generally relating to required training on retirement benefits for 12 public school employees.

- 22 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL

- 4 (II) IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ONE OR MORE OF THE 5 SUPPLEMENTAL RETIREMENT PLANS SPECIFIED UNDER TITLE 35 OF THE STATE 6 PERSONNEL AND PENSIONS ARTICLE.
- 7 (B) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A TRAINING PROGRAM FOR
 8 PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ON THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS THAT ARE AVAILABLE
 9 TO THE EMPLOYEES THROUGH THE STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM AND
 10 THE MARYLAND SUPPLEMENTAL RETIREMENT PLANS.
- 11 (2) AT LEAST ONCE PER YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL OFFER THE 12 TRAINING PROGRAM TO PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES.
- 13 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL WORK IN CONSULTATION WITH STAFF FROM
 14 THE STATE RETIREMENT AGENCY AND STAFF FROM THE MARYLAND
 15 SUPPLEMENTAL RETIREMENT PLANS TO PROVIDE THE TRAINING PROGRAM TO
 16 PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES.
- 17 (D) EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL 18 EMPLOYEE TO:
- 19 (1) ATTEND THE TRAINING PROGRAM; AND
- 20 (2) PROVIDE WRITTEN CONFIRMATION TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT 21 THE EMPLOYEE COMPLETED THE TRAINING REQUIREMENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
