3 4 5	[(b)] (C) (1) Any siblings who are separated due to a foster care or adoptive placement may petition a court, including a juvenile court with jurisdiction over one or more of the siblings, for reasonable sibling visitation rights.				
6 7	(2) If a petitioner under this subsection petitions a court to issue a visitation decree or to amend an order, the court:				
8 9	(i) may hold a hearing to determine whether visitation is in the best interest of the children;				
10 11 12	(ii) shall weigh the relative interests of each child and base its decision on the best interests of the children promoting the greatest welfare and least harm to the children; and				
13	(iii) may issue an appropriate order or decree.
