Health Insurance - Prior Authorization for Opioid Antagonists - Prohibition <u>Authorization</u>

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting authorizing certain insurers, nonprofit health service plans,
 and health maintenance organizations from applying a preauthorization to apply a
 prior authorization requirement for opioid antagonist drug products only under
 certain circumstances; providing for the application of this Act; providing for a
 delayed effective date; and generally relating to health insurance coverage for opioid

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

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(A) IN THIS SECTION, "OPIOID ANTAGONIST" MEANS:

(1) NALOXONE HYDROCHLORIDE; OR

3 (2) ANY OTHER SIMILARLY ACTING AND EQUALLY SAFE DRUG 4 APPROVED BY THE FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION FOR THE 5 TREATMENT OF A DRUG OVERDOSE.

6 (B) (1) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:

7 (I) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT 8 PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS UNDER INDIVIDUAL, GROUP, OR 9 BLANKET HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR 10 DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND

11 (II) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE 12 COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS UNDER GROUP CONTRACTS THAT ARE 13 ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.

14(2) AN INSURER, A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN, OR A HEALTH15MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION THAT PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION16DRUGS THROUGH A PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER IS SUBJECT TO THE17REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

18 (C) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION THAT INCLUDES ON ITS 19 FORMULARY AN OPIOID ANTAGONIST MAY NOT APPLY A PRIOR AUTHORIZATION 20 REQUIREMENT FOR THE OPIOID ANTAGONIST ONLY APPLY A PRIOR AUTHORIZATION 21 REQUIREMENT FOR AN OPIOID ANTAGONIST IF THE ENTITY PROVIDES COVERAGE 22 FOR AT LEAST ONE FORMULATION OF THE OPIOID ANTAGONIST WITHOUT A PRIOR 23 AUTHORIZATION REQUIREMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all policies, contracts, and health benefit plans issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or after January 1, 2018.

27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 January 1, 2018.
