## Education – Ethical Special Education Advocate Certificate Program

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to establish the Ethical 4 Special Education Advocate Certificate Program on or before a certain date; specifying the purpose of the Program; specifying certain qualifications and 5 6 application procedures for a certain certificate; requiring the Department to issue a 7 certificate to any applicant who meets certain requirements; authorizing an 8 applicant to petition for judicial review of a decision of the Department that relates 9 to issuing or renewing a certificate; providing that a certificate authorizes an individual to represent to the public that the individual is a certified ethical special 10 11 education advocate while the certificate is effective; providing for the renewal of a 12 certificate; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the Ethical Special Education Advocate Certificate 13 14 Program.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE ETHICAL SPECIAL
- 25 EDUCATION ADVOCATE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT.



- 1 (B) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2018, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AN 2 ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVOCATE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM.
- 3 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO 4 ADMINISTER A VOLUNTARY CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FOR ETHICAL SPECIAL
- 5 EDUCATION ADVOCATES.
- 6 (D) TO APPLY FOR A CERTIFICATE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:
- 7 (1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT ON THE FORM 8 THAT THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES; AND
- 9 (2) PAY TO THE DEPARTMENT THE APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE 10 DEPARTMENT.
- 11 (E) TO QUALIFY FOR A CERTIFICATE AS AN ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION 12 ADVOCATE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE FOLLOWING 13 REQUIREMENTS:
- 14 (1) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER;
- 15 (2) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD; AND
- 16 (3) THE APPLICANT SHALL AT A MINIMUM:
- 17 (I) HAVE COMPLETED AN ONLINE TRAINING MODULE OR
- 18 WEBINAR APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT THAT INCLUDES TRAINING ON THE
- 19 ETHICAL GUIDELINES AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF
- 20 PARENT ADVOCATES AND ATTORNEYS VOLUNTARY CODE OF ETHICS FOR SPECIAL
- 21 EDUCATION ADVOCATES; AND
- 22 (II) PASS AN ONLINE EXAMINATION APPROVED BY THE BOARD 23 ON THE ONLINE TRAINING MODULE OR WEBINAR.
- 24 (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A CERTIFICATE TO ANY APPLICANT 25 WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 26 (G) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE ON EACH CERTIFICATE THAT THE 27 BOARD ISSUES:
- 28 (1) THE FULL NAME OF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER; AND

- 1 (2) A SERIAL NUMBER.
- 2 (H) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A CERTIFICATE TO REPLACE A LOST,
- 3 DESTROYED, OR MUTILATED CERTIFICATE IF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER PAYS THE
- 4 CERTIFICATE REPLACEMENT FEE SET BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 5 (I) AN APPLICANT TO WHOM THE DEPARTMENT HAS ISSUED A
- 6 CERTIFICATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL MAINTAIN ON FILE WITH THE
- 7 DEPARTMENT THE APPLICANT'S CURRENT RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS AND BUSINESS
- 8 ADDRESS AND UPDATE THE INFORMATION WHENEVER CHANGES IN RESIDENCY OR
- 9 EMPLOYMENT OCCUR.
- 10 (J) THE APPLICANT MAY PETITION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A DECISION
- 11 OF THE DEPARTMENT THAT RELATES TO ISSUING OR RENEWING A CERTIFICATE AS
- 12 ALLOWED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.
- 13 (K) A CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZES AN INDIVIDUAL TO REPRESENT TO THE
- 14 PUBLIC THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS A CERTIFIED ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION
- 15 ADVOCATE WHILE THE CERTIFICATE IS EFFECTIVE.
- 16 (L) (1) A CERTIFICATE EXPIRES ON A DATE SET BY THE DEPARTMENT,
- 17 UNLESS THE CERTIFICATE IS RENEWED FOR AN ADDITIONAL TERM AS PROVIDED IN
- 18 THIS SECTION.
- 19 (2) A CERTIFICATE MAY NOT BE RENEWED FOR A TERM LONGER THAN
- 20 **2 YEARS.**
- 21 (M) AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES, THE
- 22 DEPARTMENT SHALL SEND TO THE CERTIFIED ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION
- 23 ADVOCATE, BY ELECTRONIC MEANS OR FIRST-CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN
- 24 ELECTRONIC OR PHYSICAL ADDRESS OF THE ADVOCATE, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT
- 25 STATES:
- 26 (1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT CERTIFICATE EXPIRES;
- 27 (2) The date by which the renewal application must be
- 28 RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED
- 29 BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES; AND
- 30 (3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.

- 1 (N) BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES, THE SPECIAL EDUCATION 2 ADVOCATE MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 2-YEAR TERM IF THE SPECIAL
- 3 EDUCATION ADVOCATE:
- 4 (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE;
- 5 (2) Pays to the Department the renewal fee set by the 6 Department; and
- 7 (3) SUBMITS TO THE DEPARTMENT:
- 8 (I) A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE 9 DEPARTMENT REQUIRES; AND
- 10 (II) SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH ANY 11 QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS SET BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR CERTIFICATE 12 RENEWAL.
- 13 (O) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL RENEW THE CERTIFICATE OF EACH SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVOCATE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 15 (P) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 16 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 18 1, 2017.
