On-Site Sewage Disposal - Historic and Culturally Significant Properties -Regulations

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment, on or before a certain date, to adopt regulations providing for the correction of failing on-site sewage 6 disposal systems located on historic and culturally significant properties; requiring the regulations to be designed to facilitate the use and preservation of, and to accommodate certain characteristics associated with, certain properties; and generally relating to on-site sewage disposal systems located on historic and culturally significant properties.

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 13 On or before December 31, 2017, the Department of the Environment shall adopt regulations that provide for the correction of failing on-site sewage disposal systems 14 15 located on historic and culturally significant properties.
- 16 (b) The regulations required under subsection (a) of this section shall be designed 17 to:
- 18 facilitate the use and preservation of a historic and culturally (1) 19 significant property; and
- 20 accommodate the special and unique characteristics associated with the 21historic and culturally significant nature of a property that impede compliance with 22generally applicable requirements for on-site sewage disposal systems.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 241, 2017.
