# A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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# Gaming – Video Lottery Facilities – Voluntary Exclusion

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a video lottery operation licensee to report to the State 4 Lottery and Gaming Control Commission the names of certain individuals on a  $\mathbf{5}$ certain voluntary exclusion list who enter or attempt to enter a video lottery facility; 6 requiring the Commission to provide certain information to certain individuals; 7 requiring a licensee to remove, without the use of certain law enforcement officers, 8 certain individuals from a video lottery facility using a certain procedure; 9 authorizing, under certain circumstances, a licensee to request that certain law enforcement officers remove certain individuals from a video lottery facility; 10 11 requiring the Commission's application for voluntary exclusion to contain certain 12information; and generally relating to the removal of individuals on the voluntary exclusion list from video lottery facilities. 13

# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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# Article – State Government

23 (e) (1) By regulation, the Commission shall adopt measures that are intended

with gambling problems who have requested to be excluded from any video lottery operation licensed under this subtitle; and provide a simple mechanism for an individual who is sober and (ii) informed to request placement on the voluntary exclusion list for a specified period of time. (3)**(I)** A video lottery operation licensee may not permit an individual on the voluntary exclusion list to enter into the video lottery facility or to play a video lottery terminal. **(II)** A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSEE SHALL REPORT TO THE COMMISSION THE NAME OF AN INDIVIDUAL ON THE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION LIST WHO: 1. ATTEMPTS TO ENTER A VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY; OR 2. IS REMOVED FROM A VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY UNDER PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION. (III) ON RECEIPT OF NOTIFICATION UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE THE INDIVIDUAL WITH RESOURCES, BY MAIL OR E-MAIL, TO ADDRESS PROBLEM GAMBLING. (4) SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, A **(I)** VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSEE SHALL, WITHOUT THE ASSISTANCE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, SECURE THE REMOVAL OF AN INDIVIDUAL ON THE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION LIST FROM THE VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY BY REQUESTING: 1. THE INDIVIDUAL TO LEAVE THE VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY; AND 2. IF A REQUEST UNDER ITEM 1 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH IS UNSUCCESSFUL, SECURITY PERSONNEL TO ESCORT THE INDIVIDUAL OUT OF THE VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY. **(II)** IF ATTEMPTS TO REMOVE AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH ARE UNSUCCESSFUL, A VIDEO LOTTERY **OPERATION LICENSEE MAY REQUEST THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS REMOVE** THE INDIVIDUAL. (5) THE COMMISSION'S APPLICATION FOR VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION

31 (5) THE COMMISSION'S APPLICATION FOR VOLUNTARY EXCLU 32 SHALL STATE THAT AN INDIVIDUAL ON THE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION LIST:

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1 (I) IS SUBJECT TO THE REMOVAL PROCEDURE UNDER 2 PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION; AND

## 3 (II) MAY BE SUBJECT TO ARREST FOR WANTON TRESPASS ON 4 PRIVATE PROPERTY UNDER § 6–403 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE.

5 [(4)] (6) The Commission may impose sanctions on a licensee in 6 accordance with this subtitle if the licensee knowingly fails to exclude from the premises of 7 the licensee an individual on the voluntary exclusion list.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2017.
