# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Real Property

### 16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "SURVIVING SPOUSE" MEANS THE SURVIVING SPOUSE 17 OF A DECEASED MORTGAGOR.

- 18**(B)** A LENDER SHALL SUBSTITUTE THE NAME OF A SURVIVING SPOUSE FOR19THE NAME OF A DECEASED MORTGAGOR IN A MORTGAGE IF THE SURVIVING SPOUSE:
- 20 (1) IS NAMED IN THE DEED OF TRUST FOR THE PROPERTY BUT IS NOT 21 NAMED IN THE MORTGAGE; AND
- 22 (2) SUBMITS TO THE LENDER:

4 (C) THE LENDER SHALL SUBSTITUTE THE NAME OF THE SURVIVING SPOUSE 5 WITHIN **30** DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF A REQUEST UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(2) OF THIS 6 SECTION.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2017.
