16	(B) A PERSON MAY NOT USE HYDRAULIC FRACTURING FOR ANY PURPOSE.
17 18	(C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO:
19 20	(1) FOR A FIRST CONVICTION, IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$50,000; AND



- 1 (2) FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION, IMPRISONMENT NOT 2 EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100,000.
