Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Cigar Shop Licenses

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a cigar shop beer, wine, and liquor license in Harford 4 County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the license to a 5 certain establishment; specifying that the license authorizes the license holder to sell 6 beer, wine, and liquor to a customer who is at least a certain age who is a member or 7 guest of a member of the license holder's cigar shop for consumption in the smoking 8 room of the cigar shop during certain hours; prohibiting the average daily receipts 9 from the sale of alcoholic beverages at the cigar shop from exceeding a certain amount; prohibiting the sale of certain products at the licensed premises; prohibiting 10 11 the transfer of the license to another location; providing that the license holder is 12 subject to certain alcohol awareness training requirements; providing for an annual fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Harford County. 13

- 16 (E) THE SALE OF MARIJUANA OR CANNABIS AT THE LICENSED PREMISES IS 17 PROHIBITED.
- 18 (F) THE LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER LOCATION.
- 19 (G) THE LICENSE HOLDER IS SUBJECT TO THE ALCOHOL AWARENESS
- 20 TRAINING REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 4–505 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 21 (H) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$500.
