1 AN ACT concerning

Procurement Preferences – Blind Industries and Services of Maryland – Janitorial Products

FOR the purpose of clarifying that the requirement that a State or State aided or controlled
entity include in certain maintenance contracts a requirement that a prime
contractor procure certain products from the Blind Industries and Services of
Maryland under certain circumstances applies to products made or, manufactured,
remanufactured, or assembled by the Blind Industries and Services of Maryland;
providing for the application of a certain provision of law; and generally relating to
procurement preferences related to the Blind Industries and Services of Maryland.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
