SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

15 [17-215.

16 A person may not directly or indirectly advertise for or solicit business in this State 17 for any medical laboratory, regardless of location, from anyone except a physician, hospital, 18 medical laboratory, clinic, clinical installation, or other medical care facility.]

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2017.
