A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Hate Crimes – Prohibitions and Protected Classes – Expansion to Law Enforcement Officers and First Responders

FOR the purpose of including law enforcement officers and first responders within the scope
of certain prohibitions against committing certain crimes against certain persons,
damaging certain property of certain persons, burning certain objects, and damaging
certain buildings with which certain persons or groups have contacts or associations
or under circumstances exhibiting animosity against a certain person or group;
defining certain terms; and generally relating to hate crimes against law
enforcement officers and first responders.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
